Chumash 6

Students should prepare the beginning of Parshat Beshalach - שמות פרק יג - פסוקים יז-כב (Shemot 13:17-22.) They should be comfortable reading the pesukim and be able to translate. They will be quizzed on the reading and translation for these pesukim at the beginning of school.

In addition, students should complete the worksheets on these pesukim. Worksheets will be collected the first week of school.

Here is a suggestion for a schedule to divide the work over 5 weeks of the summer. Each assignment should take around 10 minutes to complete:

Week 1: Read and translate פסוק יז and complete sheet 1-2.

Week 2: Read and translate פסוקים יח-יט and complete sheet 3-4.

Week 3: Read and translate פסוקים כ-כא and complete sheet 5-6.

Week 4: Review all pesukim and answer questions on sheet 7.

Week 5: Review all pesukim and prepare for quiz in school.

The Long Way:

Hashem did not take בני ישראל on the shortest, most direct route, through the land of the Plishtim. The פסוק explains that this was for their own good, as they were not yet ready to face the wars that lay ahead. Sometimes, when things don't go as easily or as directly as we would like, we trust that Hashem is looking out for our best interests. While a delay or complication seems like a bother, Hashem does everything, ultimately, for our best interests.

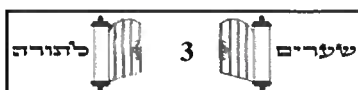

Avoid Tests

- Hashem takes בני ישראל through the מדבר to סוף ים, avoiding a situation where they will be tempted to run back to Mitzrayim. We can learn from here how important it is to avoid situations where we may be tempted to do the wrong thing.
- Each morning we daven that Hashem should not bring us into circumstances which will test our resolve to keep his Torah. לא תביאנו ואל נסיון לידי ולא ועון עבירה לידי. It is not enough just to ask Hashem. We need to make every effort to avoid situations of nisayon.
